Not all committees are required to meet formally, and in that case, updates on working parties, areas for concern and progress reports are submitted to the Full Governing Body.

Members of the Full Governing Body also have individual responsibilities. We call those working with a Curriculum subject Link Governors, because they create a valuable link between the Governing Body and Subject Leaders within the Teaching Staff.
